He was an outstanding supporter of the church. The A.M. E. Church honored William as Trinity’s oldest active male in July 2001. He was also honored last year during Black History month as one of Trinity’s “Pints of Light”. He dearly loved his church and he will be sorely missed. He was kind, quiet, unassuming, and was loved by all who knew him.
