Willie Arthur Falcon, the son of the late Abraham and Mattie Falcon, was born on March 30, 1921 in Warrenton, North Carolina. He was called home on March 25, 2002 at Sinai Hospital. He attended the public schools in Warrenton county, North Carolina. Later in life he joined the U.S. arm: after being honorably discharged from the military, he joined and remained an active member in the VFW in Baltimore, Maryland. He was employed at the Veterans Administration Hospital and retired from the Social Security Administration in 1985 after more than thirty years of government service. Willie accepted Christ as his Savior and was baptized at an early age at New Bethel Baptist Church in Warrenton County, North Carolina.
