On August 1, 2020, Dr. Willie A. Bragg fell in the Master's arms at her home in Perry Hall, Maryland. She is the daughter of the Late Robert and Gladys L. Bragg of Piscataway, New Jersey. She attended and graduated from Rahway High School, Rahway, New Jersey and furthered her education at Morgan State University in Baltimore, Maryland. Dr. Bragg received her B.S. degree from MSU in Elementary Education, a M.A. in Education/Early Childhood Education from Fisk University, Nashville, Tennessee, and a PhD. in Special Education from Indiana University, Bloomington, Indiana. She completed a Post-doctoral Fellowship on Exceptional Programs for Culturally and Linguistically Diverse Children and Youth with Disabilities at the University of California, Santa Barbara. Dr. Bragg's activities at Morgan State include, but are not limited to, directing grants and contracts from federal agencies, development of international partnerships, (William V.S. Tubman University, Liberia), and securing a million-dollar endowment from the Bernard Osher Foundation specifically geared for nontraditional students at MSU. At Morgan State University, Dr. Bragg served as Assistant Dean, School of Graduate Studies, Director, Center for Continuing and Professional Studies, and founder of the Bernard Osher Scholarship at her Alma Mater. She leaves to mourn a devoted sister, Dr. Cynthia B. Bragg, Perry Hall,

Maryland; one brother, Elder Alvin L. Bragg of New Brunswick, New Jersey; three sisters-in-law, nephews, nieces, cousins, and a host of other relatives, church associates and friends..

Dr. Bragg also served as a mentor to countless graduate students pursuing master's and doctoral degrees. She served tirelessly on numerous dissertation committees and counted it as her personal and professional mission to encourage and support the next generation of scholars.
