WILLIE BUCKSON SR., son of the late Racheal Buckson and Wade Buckson Sr., was born November 28, 1929 in Fairfield County, South Carolina. Willie departed this life on April 3, 2008 after a short illness at the Veterans Hospital in Baltimore, Maryland. He accepted Christ at an early age and received his education in the South Carolina school system. Buck, as he was better known, served in the United States Army from 1951-1953 and was honorably discharged. As a child, Buck met and fell in love with Fannie Mae McClurkin. Later in 1961 they married, and out of that union three children were born (Willie "Skip" Buckson Jr. preceded him in death). He also accepted and loved her three children from a previous marriage. Buck was employed by Bethlehem Steel Shipyard for thirty-five years and retired in 1992. In his spare time he loved playing checkers, cards and hunting with family and friends.
