



## WILLIE MAE CANNON

February 22, 1930 - February 24, 2020

Willie Mae Cannon was born to the late Willie and Minner on February 22, 1930, in North, South Carolina. On Monday, February 24, 2020, God called Willie Mae from her earthly home to her eternal resting place.

At an early age, Willie Mae accepted Christ as her Savior and was baptized in the Methodist Church. She received her formal education in the public schools of North, South Carolina, where she enjoyed playing basketball. On April 17, 1948, Herman Cannon of South Carolina married Willie Mae, and from this union, six children were born. Her husband preceded her in death.

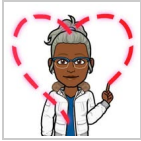
