WILLIE LEE LOGAN, son of the late Emma Logan, was born on March 29, 1923 in Chase City, Virginia. He departed this life on November 17, 2012.

he received his education in the Virginia School System. Most of his education was received from elders and through life experience. He plowed the fields and picked tobacco and cotton. It was during those times he was taught by the sharecroppers. His mother left Virginia and moved to Baltimore in 1938. At the age of fifteen, his first job was as a ship cleaner where he was employed for ten years; after which he joined the United States Army and served for three years, spending one year overseas. Upon honorable discharge, he was employed with Rice's Bakery for ten years, then became employed with the Baltimore Department of Sanitation. He retired from there in 1988.

He married his long-time love, Ada Mae Pullet. The two remained together for fifty-plus years. Willie, or Mr. Bill as he was called, was adored by all who met him. Going to the races (as he called it) was his favorite thing to do.

He leaves to mourn: his wife, Ada Mae Logan; two sons, William Logan and James Pullet; three daughters, Cynthia Pullet, Gwen Pullet and Felisa Pullet; three grandsons, Marvin William and Keith; six granddaughters, Kiesha, Cintaria, Shantel, Ashley, Michelle and Felisa (one brother and two grandsons preceded him in death, Garnett, and Lamont and Bernie "LB");
