WILLIE JAMES PRINCE, son of the late Ralph and Roxana Prince was born on September 2, 1930 in Garysburg, North Carolina. He departed this life on November 5, 2010 after a lengthy illness.

After graduating from high school on May 25, 1951, he was inducted into the United States Army. While enlisted, he served in the Korean War, where he received the Korean Service Medal, with four (4) Bronze Service Stars and the United Nations Service Medal. Prince later transferred to Army Reserve on May 8, 1953 and received an honorable discharge on January 22, 1957.

Prince, as he was affectionately known, became an entrepreneur, owned and operated his own Dry Cleaner Service. Prince loved talking about God, singing, socializing with people and his family. Prince was a member of New Pleasant Grove Missionary Baptist Church. While at New Pleasant Grove, Deacon Prince was a School Superintendent, School Instructor, member of the Evangelism Class, member of "Where do I go from here" class, member of the Bible Study Class member of the Board of Christian Education, Delegate of the National Baptist Congress of Christian Education, and in 1989, he participated in the Local Church Wide Institutes and Seminars.

He married the former Rosie Dickerson in 1970. Prince made numerous friends and will be sincerely missed by everyone who knew him. He was

always a true friend and a devoted family man.

He was preceded in death by his daughter, Linda Collins.

He leaves to cherish his memory: his beloved wife of forty years, Rosie Prince; sister, Lenore Vicks; daughter, Wanda Nash (Norman); stepdaughter, Rhonda Tenson; two stepsons, Ronald Tenson and Hubert Dickerson; four grandchildren, Twana Hamilton (Phillip), Michael Prince, Tiffany Dickerson and Devon Dickerson; two great-grandchildren, Marquise Harris and Devon Dickerson, Jr., (Miesha); and a host of nieces, nephew and other relatives and friends; and two devoted friends, Donald Drumsgoale and Deacon Leon Martin.
