



## Willie L. Pushia

February 5, 1939 - June 15, 2014

Deacon Willie Louis Pushia, son of the late Dock and Elizabeth Pushia, was born on February 5, 1939 in SC. He departed this life after a brief illness on June 15, 2014.

He received his early education in the South Carolina Public School System and graduated from the Paul Laurence Dunbar High School in Baltimore, MD. Willie was employed with the Hold Tight Manufacturing Co, Job Corps and Harry T. Campbell Co in the 1960's. In 1970, Willie went to work for the Baltimore Gas & Electric Co. (BGE) as a Stock Clerk and retired in 1994. Afterwards he worked for Papa & Fisher Auto Parts delivering Auto Parts. He married the former Barbara Ann Boone on December 6, 1967 and from this union one son, Kevin, was born.

Willie received Christ at an early age and was baptized. He was a longtime member of Southern Baptist Church under the leadership of the late Rev. Dr. Nathaniel Higgs, the Mt. Hebron Baptist Church of Clifton Park under the leadership of the Rev. Anthony Johnson, the Greater Mt. Zion Baptist Church under the leadership of the Rev. James E. Butler. It was at Greater Mt. Zion where Willie was ordained a Deacon. He also was a founding member and Deacon at the Greater Faith Church of Deliverance under the leadership of his son, +Bis. Kevin J. Pushia, D.D. and a Deacon at the Christ Spiritual Temple Baptist Church, Inc. under the leadership of his godson, +Bis. George E. M. Stanton, D.Min.

His brothers, Mack, Roy and Buster and sisters, Sadie & Janie Mae preceded

him in death.
