On Friday, December 24, 2004, peacefully and quietly, Wilson Quinn Lymon Sr. departed this world. Quinn, an only child, was born on November 6, 1946 in Hampshire, TN to the late Wilson Lymon and Alberta Lymon-Teagle. Quinn and his parents moved to Baltimore MD where he attended Baltimore City College High School and graduated in 1964. After graduation he voluntarily joined the United States Marine Corps, where he served one tour of duty in the Vietnam Conflict. After receiving an Honorable Discharge, he obtained an Associate of Arts degree. He later married his childhood neighbor and sweetheart Carolyn Jean Coppage, and from that thirty-five year marriage two sons were born. Quinn served as a Baltimore City Public School Police Officer for thirty years where he retired and was presently serving as an officer for the State of Maryland in Annapolis. Quinn, an avid firearm specialist, was also a Maryland State Certified Firearms Instructor where he has certified numerous officers over the years. Wherever he worked, socialized or traveled Quinn made many friends, and his family-oriented values and his loyalty will be sincerely missed. He leaves to cherish his memory: his wife, Carolyn Jean Lymon; two sons, Wilson Q. Lymon Jr. and Hari T. Lymon; daughter-in-law, Marie Lymon; three grandsons, K'aree Quinn Lymon, Kylon Quinn Lymon, and Kaden Quinn Lymon; three extended sons, Jonathan Brickus, William Harris, and Osiris Lofton; aunt, Annie C. I really miss you and I feel you protecting me, all of us and the connection never fades, it never dies. Its in the stillness I remember how you carried us,loved us and no matter what showed up for us. I rarely feel that kind of protection these days, they don't make them like you any more.
