Minister Yvonne Cox “Cooky” Conyers, 62, of Richmond, departed this life October 10, 2017. She was born August 30, 1955 to the union of Ruth Smith and the late Milton Cox, Sr. She was preceded in death by her brother, Lester Cox.

She was educated in the Richmond Public School System and graduated from John Marshall High School, Class of 1973. Minister Conyers became a licensed minister in 2003. She furthered her education at the Samuel DeWitt Proctor School of Theology, Virginia Union University in 2004. She was ordained as a minister in 2012.
