



## Mr. Zannie Jernigan Jr.

October 20, 1942 - November 16, 2020

On Monday, November 16 2020, God extended his hands to welcome Zannie Jernigan, Jr. into the Peaceful Gates of Heaven and said, "Well done my good and faithful servant". Zannie Jernigan, Jr., son of the late Zannie Sr. and Lillie Mae Jernigan, was the third of eight children. He was born and raised in Winton, North Carolina. Zannie received his education in the North Carolina public school system. Upon completion of his education, he enlisted in the United States Army, where he retired at the rank of Sergeant First Class after serving 23 years. Zannie was employed as a security supervisor for Bon Secours Hospital for 29.5 years before retiring in 2004. After retiring, he took off his badge, hung up his belt and said "Honey, I'm home". Zannie received Christ at an early age. He was a member of Wildwood Parkway Methodist Church and Unity United Methodist Church, where he served as an usher for years. He recently became a member of Oak Street A.M.E. Church. Zannie, affectionately referred to as "Honey", "Junior", "Jernigan" and "De-Daddy", married Theresa Griffin on August 31, 1997. Zannie and Theresa both belong to the Interdenominational Church Ushers Association of Maryland (I.C.U.A.) where he served on the Board of Directors. He enjoyed watching television, attending car shows, crab feasts, bull roasts, and other social gatherings. Zannie is survived by his devoted wife Theresa; four sisters: Mary Louise Knight of Florida, Joann (Dupree) Manley of New York, Gloria Shuler of New York, and Maxine Jernigan of North Carolina; three brothers: Kenneth, Milton and Johnnie (Virginia) Jernigan of North Carolina; seven children:
